



**NOTICE**

An Errata to Addendum (dated Jan 23, 2003) to SCOSTA Version 1.2b (dated March 15, 2002) was published on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2006. In view of that following process will be adopted for issuance/renewal of SCOSTA compliance certificate: -

- All existing certificate holders are required to incorporate the changes and get their product revalidated/certified within six months from the date of issue of this notice.
- Validity of renewed certificate on old version shall be made only up to six months from the date of issue of this notice. If the applicant requires to get renewed the existing certificate on the new version, it shall be renewed for complete one year after successful testing.
- All the existing valid certificate holders are required to get their modified product (as per new version) tested and certified before the expiry of the above said period for which there shall be no extra cost/fee.
- All existing certificates as per old version, if not renewed for incorporating new version (changes) within the above said period shall be treated as cancelled, for which information shall be published on the official SCOSTA web site (<http://www.scosta.gov.in>)
- An undertaking shall be required to be submitted by all the applicants to ensure that necessary actions has been taken by the applicant to discontinue the supply of obsolete product in the market, after the expiry as stated above.
